



Mounting Suggestions for the Honda VTX1300 Retro, S & T Two-Piece Seat

Tools Required:

- 6 mm Allen Wrench
- 8 mm Allen Wrench

Hardware:

- Stock 6 mm Fender Screw
- Stock 8 mm Allen Bolt



Baseplate Features:

The two-piece, marine-grade fiberglass baseplate is a direct replacement for the stock two-piece seat. Rubber bumpers are positioned to protect the frame and fender.

Stock Seat Removal Steps

1. Remove the stock rear 6 mm fender screw and the stock 8 mm screw on each side of the passenger seat. These will be used again to mount your new Mustang Two-Piece Seat.
2. Lift passenger seat and hand strap off bike.
3. Remove the two stock 8 mm solo bolts. These will be used again to mount the Solo of your new Mustang Two-Piece Seat

Lift rear of solo up and the slide back to remove.

4. Remove the two stock 8 mm screws holding the passenger seat mounting bracket to the fender. Remove the bracket as it is not used with the Mustang seat.
5. Reinstall two stock screws in fender holes.

Mounting of Mustang

1. Slide the nose bracket into the receiver under the fuel tank. Make sure the bracket goes into the receiver and not on top.
2. Push the solo forward until the side brackets line up with the frame mounts. Secure the solo with the stock 8 mm bolts.
3. Slide the tongue (Fig. I) on the front of the passenger seat into the receiver (Fig. II) on the solo seat.
4. Push the passenger seat forward to align the rear mounting bracket with the fender hole. Secure using the stock 6 mm screw to complete the installation process.
