ATTENTION! Secure all straps away from visible painted surfaces, moving parts, pinch points or extreme heat.

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface; turn off the ignition and allow the engine to cool.

SUGGESTIONS FOR MOUNTING

STEP 2 This bag can be mounted in many different ways. As you can see in PIC 1 & 2, it is on a rack with the lid opening up and forward. It is being fastened by running the strap with the steel hooks forward under the backrest pad. The small strap is running under the rack. The D rings give you extra ways (using bungee cords) to further secure the bag to your bike.

Note PIC 3 shows the size of this bag when it is expanded. A full-face helmet can fit inside the bag.

STEP 3 If you prefer, you can turn this bag into a comfortable backpack that can be safely worn while riding your bike or once you get to your destination. In addition to the padded shoulder straps, there is an additional strap that goes around your waist/chest to keep it in place.

PROCEDURE FOR MOUNTING/SECURING TO PASSENGER BACKREST

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

STEP 2 To install the Jaunt bag on a backrest, install the Y-strap as shown in PIC 4.

STEP 3 Place the Y-strap over the backrest and insert it through the lower D-ring, securing the hook and loop as shown in PIC 5.

STEP 4 Use the 8" straps and secure the bag around the arms of the backrest using the lower D-rings as shown in PIC 5.

STEP 5 If the backrest has a luggage rack, you also may use additional straps on the bag for added security.

STEP 6 To use the shoulder strap, secure it to the D-Rings on top of the bag.

WARRANTY: All Mustang seats and accessories have a one-year warranty against defects in material and workmanship. Your warranty is automatically activated on date of purchase.
