MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Kawasaki Vulcan 2000 Classic & LT Fender Bib

Note: Mustang recommends removal of the fender bib before installing a passenger seat. Mounting a passenger seat over a fender bib may result in damage to the bib, poor seat alignment or other

<u>Installation of Mustang fender bib:</u>

- 1. Remove the seat from the motorcycle.
- 2. Remove the rear seat mounting brackets using a 10mm socket wrench. Reinstall the center bracket bolts into the fender.
- 3. Position the bib on the fender, then install solo over the bib.
- 4. Align the fender bib's rear mounting holes with the fender mounts and fasten with the supplied chrome 6mm Allen bolts and washers using a 4mm Allen wrench.
