



## MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

### Harley-Davidson® Softail Deuce 2000-2007 Sissy Bar Pad with Built-in Extension

**Hardware:**       $\frac{5}{16}$ "-18 x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " bolt  
                          $\frac{5}{16}$ "-18 x 1" bolt  
                         Acorn nut  
                         Washers

**Tools needed:**    SAE wrenches



To install the Mustang sissy bar, Harley-Davidson® Chrome Passenger Sissy Bar Upright 51114-00 must first be mounted to the fender.



## Installation of Pad:

Theissy bar pad mounts directly to the stock bar. Use the  $\frac{5}{16}$ "-18 x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " bolt to secure the top mount and the  $\frac{5}{16}$ "-18 x 1" bolt on the bottom.



The lower bolt can be installed with the acorn nut on the front or the back as desired.



The Harley-Davidson® Chrome Luggage Rack 53806-00 comes with two 3/8"-16 x 1 1/4" bolts and lock nuts, and will mount with the Mustang sissy bar pad. The top bolt provided with the pad is used. To install with the luggage rack, the material must be punched for the second bolt.
