



MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Suzuki C109R 2008-2010 Solo and Passenger Seat

Hardware:	Solo seat: 6mm x 25mm hex bolt x 2 Spool washer x 2	Passenger seat: Stock 8mm rear screw Black $\frac{1}{8}$ " nylon washer
Tools needed:	Metric socket and Allen wrenches	

Note: The stock rear seat will not fit with the Mustang solo.

Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Remove the rear fender screw and set aside. This will be used to mount your new Mustang seat.
2. Slide passenger seat back and up to remove.
3. Remove the handstrap and bracket from the fender by removing the two Allen bolts.
4. Lift rear of solo and slide back and up to remove.



Installation of Mustang Seat:

1. Engage the front solo bracket into the frame receiver under the fuel tank.
2. Slide the solo forward until the rear solo bracket aligns with the holes in the fender. . If installing a passenger seat as well, place a spool washer over each bracket hole. Secure the solo and spool washers to the fender with the provided 6mm x 25mm hex bolts.



3. Position the passenger seat on the fender and slide it forward until the front forked bracket engages the spool washers.
4. Push the passenger seat fully forward until the rear bracket aligns with the rear fender mount.



5. Position the black $\frac{1}{8}$ " nylon washer between the rear bracket and the fender, and secure to the fender with the stock 8mm rear bolt and metal washer.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
