

#### **MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:**

# Victory Cross Roads/Cross Country 2010-17 – Sissy Bar Pad

Hardware: Stock 4mm Allen screws x 4

6mm x 15mm Allen bolt x 4

Chrome washer x 4 Black U-bracket

Tools needed: 4mm Allen wrench

#### Removal of Stock Sissy Bar Pad:

- 1. Unhook the hook-and-loop fastener on the cover and slide the cover up and off the foam.
- 2. Remove the four stock 4mm Allen screws using a 4mm Allen wrench.
- 3. Slide the foam up and off the bar.

### Mounting Mustang Sissy Bar Pad:

- 1. Mount the black U-bracket to the Victory sissy bar with the stock 4mm screws.
- Keeping the side flaps secured, open the center flap on the back of the pad and slide the pad onto the bar.
- 3. Once the pad is over the Ubracket, close the center flap. Align the holes in the pad with the holes in the U-bracket.
- 4. Secure the pad to the U-bracket with the supplied 6mm bolts and washers using a 4mm Allen wrench.
