



MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Honda Gold Wing GL1800 2001-2017 Passenger Backrest

Hardware:	1/4"-20 x 3/4" screw x 2
Tools needed:	Phillips screwdriver

Note: Be sure you have the correct backrest for your application. If your model has OEM heat, use backrest 79906 (white plug). If your model does not have OEM heat and you are installing Mustang heated seat 79907, use backrest 79908 (black plug).

Removal of stock backrest:

1. Open Tour-Pak and remove the two backrest mounting screws.
2. Close the Tour-Pak. Lift the backrest up and off.



Installation of Mustang backrest:

1. If heated, disconnect the battery, then connect the cable to either the OEM backrest heater connector (white plug) or the pigtail on Mustang seat 79907's rear heater (black plug).
2. Remove the screws from the backrest and slide the backrest brackets into the recesses on the Tour-Pak.
3. Open the Tour-Pak and align the mounting holes of the backrest with those on the Tour-Pak.
4. Insert and secure the supplied 1/4"-20 x 3/4" screws through the Tour-Pak and into the backrest. Reconnect the battery.
