



## MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

### Yamaha Road Star Warrior 1700 '02-03 Solo and Passenger Seat

<b>Hardware:</b>	<b>Solo:</b> <i>No hardware needed</i>	<b>Passenger seat:</b> Stock 6mm fender bolt x 2
<b>Tools needed:</b>	Metric socket wrenches	

**Note:** This seat installs only on 2002 and 2003 models. Other Road Star Warrior years will use the standard Road Star seats.

#### Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Insert ignition key into the left side cover and turn counter-clockwise to release seat latch and remove solo seat.
2. Lift the nose, slide the seat forward, and lift the seat off the motorcycle.
3. Remove the tool bag from the frame and re-attach the elastic straps.



## Installation of Mustang Seat:

1. Slide the passenger seat back into the rear fender U-bracket.
2. Using the stock 6mm bolts, fasten the front passenger seat bracket to the front fender bracket.



3. Slide the tool bag under the elastic shock cord on the solo's baseplate.



4. Tip the solo back and fully engage the solo's rear bracket into the fender bracket.

5. Pivot the solo down and engage the front bracket into the frame latch. Push nose of seat down firmly until it clicks, signifying the seat is latched into position. Ensure this bracket is firmly engaged before riding.
