



MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Yamaha Royal Star Deluxe 2005-2009 Solo and Passenger Seat

Hardware:	Solo seat: Stock side 8mm Allen bolts x 2	Passenger seat: Stock rear 8mm hex bolt
Tools needed:	10mm open-end wrench 5mm Allen wrench	

Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Remove the stock 8mm Allen bolts from either side of the front of the solo using a 5mm Allen wrench.



2. Lift the nose of the seat up, then pull seat forward to disengage from the receiver.

3. Remove the passenger seat's rear 8mm hex bolt with a 10mm open-end wrench. Slide the passenger seat forward to disengage it from the fender bracket and lift off the motorcycle.

Installation of Mustang Seat:

1. Position the passenger seat on the fender and slide it back so the seat brackets engage the fender bracket.



2. Align the passenger seat's rear bracket with the frame mount. Secure to fender with the stock 8mm hex bolt using a 10mm open-end wrench.

3. Holding the solo with the nose tipped up, engage the rear bracket with the receiver. Pivot the solo down and align the side brackets with the frame mounts.

4. Secure the solo with the two stock 8mm Allen bolts using a 6mm Allen wrench.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
