



MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Honda GL1500 Valkyrie/Interstate '97-03 - Solo and Passenger Seat

Hardware:	Solo seat: <i>No hardware needed</i>	Passenger seat: Stock rear bolt Stock front bolts OR Mustang part 78042
Tools needed:	Metric Allen wrenches	

Note: To install a passenger seat on Interstate 1999-2001 models, Mustang part 78042 is required. If you did not receive these bolts with your new seat, please call your salesperson and request these free of charge.

Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Insert the ignition key into the lock on left side cover and turn to unlock the seat.

2. Interstate models: Remove the rear Allen screw, pull the nose of the seat up, and slide forward to remove. Continue to installation instructions on page 2.

3. Other Valkyrie models: Pull the nose of the solo up and slide it forward to remove.



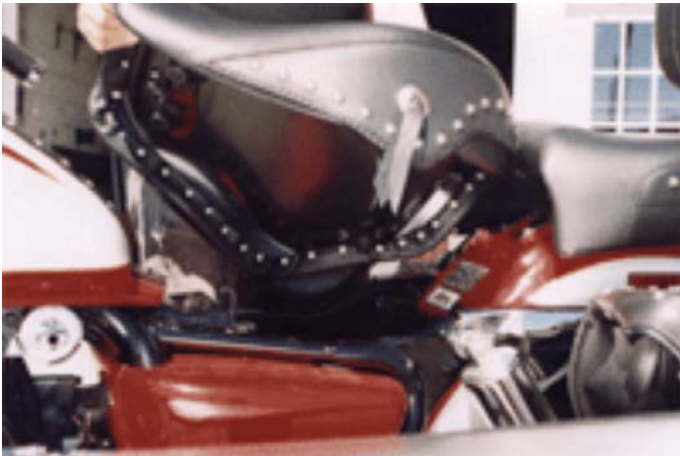
4. Remove the two Allen bolts from the front of the passenger seat and the Allen bolt at the back of the passenger seat and set aside. These will be used to mount your Mustang passenger seat.

5. Lift passenger seat from fender to remove.

Installation of Mustang Seat:

1. Interstate models: locate and remove the two 1/2" round decals on the fender to expose the two front rear seat mounts.

2. Position the passenger seat on the fender and mount with the stock 8mm Allen bolt at the back and the stock 6mm bolts or Mustang part 78042 at the front.



3. Slide the solo's rear bracket into the fender mount. Check to be certain the seat skirt is not tucked under the seat and interfering with install.
4. Pivot the seat down until the front bracket engages the frame latch and a click is heard. Ensure this latch is secure before riding.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
